Classification Title: [Production] Test Technician (FT, Non-Exempt)

Department: Production, Test

Reports to: Production Director
Test Supervisor

Basic Purpose:

Test, troubleshoot and repair electronic home audio equipment.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Utilize test equipment to troubleshoot analog and digital circuits down to component level.
- Perform test processes for existing products and produce or assist in production of test processes for new products.
- Communicate with production supervisors and/or engineering personnel with recommended changes in test/build processes.
- Produce simple daily, weekly, and monthly reports to assist in production flow and failure trend analysis.
- Perform other duties as requested or required.
- Checking cables and connections, power distribution, signal paths and control systems.
- Isolating faults to the level of PC boards
- Using computer-controlled test systems
- Tuning electronic circuits, using instruments to guide the process
- Learning all products over time – amplifiers, preamplifiers, tuners, turn tables and more.
- Debug and repair is limited to about 20% of total work time.
- Attendance
- Being prompt and on time for scheduled shift.

- Experience with building and testing analog circuits.
- Bench testing – up to 50 units per day.
- Prior experience with the test gear is beneficial. 20 Hz to 50 kHz. Oscilloscopes, distortion analyzers, volt meters.
